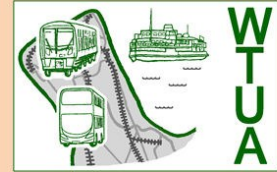

Doing Things Differently



Huw will talk about the new Local Transport Plan for the Liverpool City Region that's in the process of being finalised – what it is, what it covers, and what it means to the people of the LCR and to people of the Wirral especially.

The plan sets a bold and ambitious vision for transport from now until 2040. It takes forward the Mayor's commitment to build a London-style transport system, to deliver a transport system that serves the needs of the city region and its people – enabling new homes, jobs and opportunities, and providing a transport system that is of high quality, inclusive, safe, simple to use, healthy and clean.

The talk will be in the **Merebrook** in Greenfields Avenue, Bromborough CH62 6DD on **Friday 17th October at 1:30 pm (doors open 1pm)** in the ground-floor function room.
